

Side Tilt Carriages

Side Tilt Carriage - Rated by the blade carriage lifting capability, there are four sizes of hook type blade carriages. The hook type tine carriages have been standardized.

The carriage bar spacing used for Class 1 is approximately 13 inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to carry loads as much as 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to carry cargo as much as 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for this capacity is twenty five inches.

Pin mounted forks differ by the amount of offset between the fork and the blade eye. Different manufacturers will vary the carriages for pin type tines. Carriage capacity would be determined by the carriage pin size and by the tine size.
